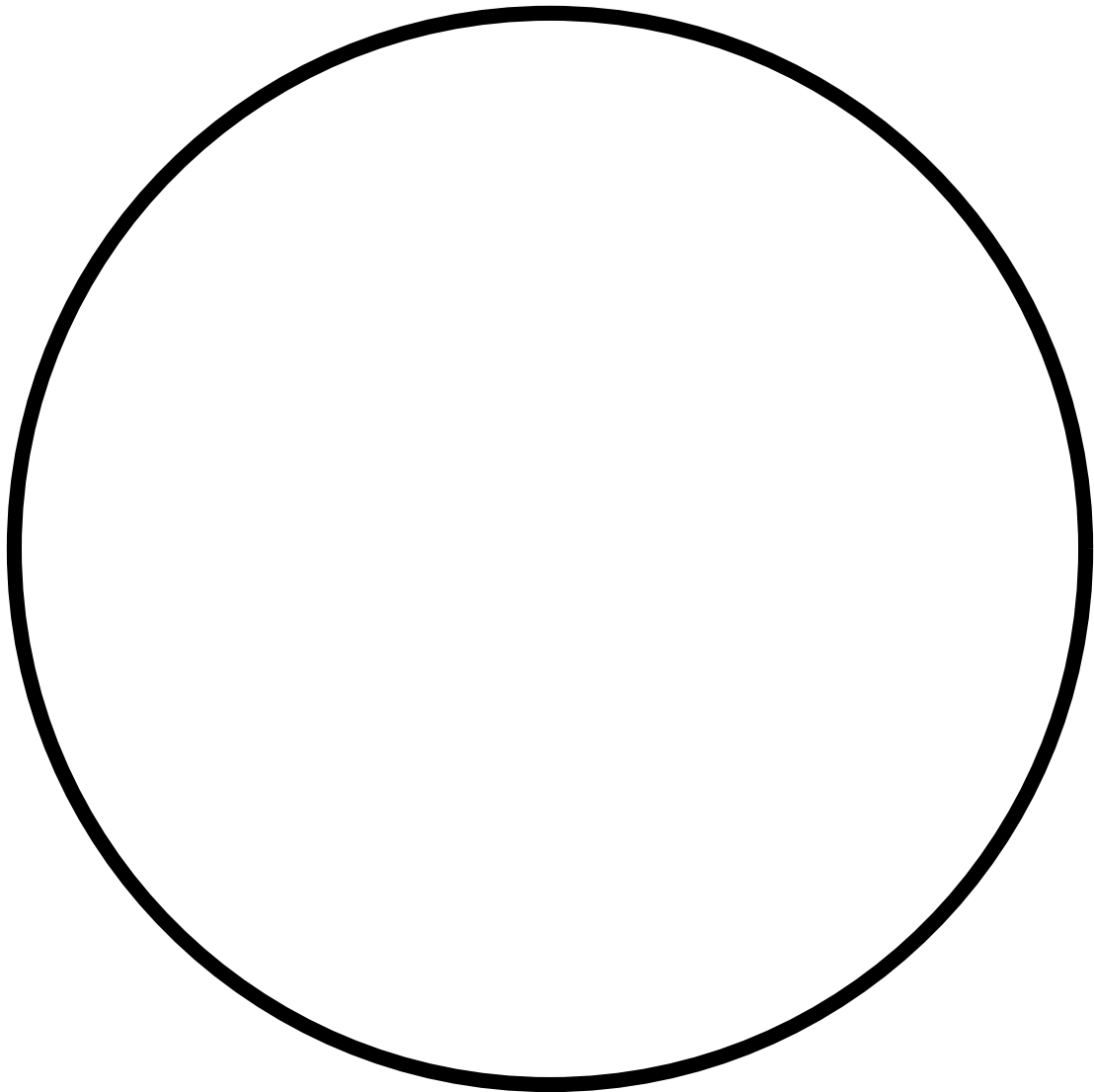

**“Future Voter” Sticker Design Contest**  
**Parental Release and Authorization**

By signing this Parental Release and Authorization:

1. I hereby agree that my minor child (“child”) may participate in the “Future Voter” Sticker Design Contest hosted by the Johnson County Election Office (“Sponsor”). I irrevocably grant my permission and authorize the Sponsor to use my minor child’s name, school, artwork, and photograph in advertising, marketing, and promoting the contest, and to reproduce and publish the same in any media, without any additional notice to or permission by me or my child.
2. I waive any right to inspect or approve the completed media, finished product, copy, or other matter relating to this Contest.
3. I release the Sponsor from any claims, demands, damages, or liability, arising directly or indirectly, based upon distribution or use of material, or based upon any element of the contest. I hereby release the Sponsor, and its licensees and assigns, from any claims or liability in relation to, or arising from, my child’s participation in the contest.
4. I acknowledge that the Sponsor has no obligation to use my child’s artwork or information in the contest. I also acknowledge that use of my child’s work may be in conjunction with other children whose artwork has been selected.
5. I agree that the contest, my child’s participation, and the contest elements belong entirely and exclusively to the Sponsor. I understand and agree that neither I nor my child will own any rights in any element of the contest or receive any monetary compensation relating to the contest.
6. I confirm that my child lives or attends school, whether public, private, or home-schooled, in Johnson County, Kansas. I consent to provide the information concerning my child that is necessary to enter the contest.
7. I agree that this consent and release will be governed by and construed in accordance with Kansas law.
8. I warrant that I am of legal age and have the right to contract in my name and on behalf of the child named below, and that I am the parent or legal guardian of the child named below, for whom this Release is granted. I have read and understand the **Rules of the “Future Voter” Contest**, which is attached and part of the Release and Authorization, and the provisions of this Release and Authorization; I agree to the terms set forth in both and agree that my child and I are bound by the terms of both. This Release and Authorization shall be binding upon me, my child, our heirs, legal representatives, and assigns.

**Johnson County, Kansas, 2024**  
**“Future Voter” Contest Rules**

1. Entries must be from students who are in grades K-8, or home-schooled students between the ages of 5 and 14.
2. Students must be residents of Johnson County, Kansas, or must attend school, whether public, private, or home-schooled, in Johnson County, Kansas.
3. Only one entry per student is permitted.
4. Student may not be a relative of an employee of the Johnson County Election Office.
5. All submitted artwork must be the student’s original artwork and may not include any copyright images or trademarks, and may not infringe upon any person’s right of privacy, publicity, or other right.
6. All submitted work will become and remain the property of the Johnson County Election Office.
7. All art work must include the phrase “Future Voter.”
8. All art work must be nonpartisan and may not promote or disparage any party, candidate, or issue, or contain language or depictions that in the determination of the Johnson County Election Office are inappropriate for use. The determination of the Johnson County Election Office shall be final.
9. Entries may be submitted using the template provided by the Johnson County Election Office or may be created using the student’s own materials.
10. All entries must include the student’s first name, last name, and the name of the student’s school.
11. A signed **Parental Release and Authorization form** must be included with the student’s entry.
